- d. Water hauling
 - i. 20 loads in March. No additional costs, some minor changes to be made.
 - Review of Policies & Procedures. Discussion regarding some revisions. Mitch will make changes to customer hand out and Joe will get them to Crystal.
 - iii. Joe sent the state a revised plan to make ourself a certified water hauling operation. He will need technical information for the environment department. Still in phase of figuring what is needed for the certification.

 - ii. Possibility of a newsletter after the pump test.
