## 5. Financial

- a. Treasurer's report: See attached
- b. Billing
  - i. What kind of late fee will we charge? Dennis will look into what other systems charge.
- c. Gene received letter from IRS regarding credits we have. We need to file the forms for Social Security and FICA for our drivers. We should be receiving an official notice that we are not required to pay taxes.

## 6. Corn Lawsuit

- b. Mr. Corn asserts that Dorothy Road will not hold up over the winter. We may have a hearing in the spring regarding this matter.

## 7. Water System

- a. Status of connections. Several people will probably hookup in the spring and stand-by bills went out this month.
- b. Selling of water from system flush (tabled from last month)
  - i. Will have to be sold as non-potable water. What does the city charge?
  - ii. The truck or tank of the purchaser must be labeled as non-potable water.
- c. Cheryl reviewed what all is involved in the sampling plan. Motion made and seconded (Crystal Dennis) to table approval of the Sampling Plan until we have final approval from Wayne Jeffs.
- d. Status of Sanitary Survey deficiencies
  - i. Hose has been purchased, but still needs the fitting.
  - ii. We are still trying to locate a good Colorimeter to test chlorine residuals

- iii. The log book was placed in the truck.
- 8. Capital Outlay
  - Ramon has completed an application for 2019 funding for construction drawings of the Coyote Loop
  - b. The board felt this was a good idea.
- 9. Water Trust Board Application Timeframe
  - a. We have been approved to move onto the next phase of the approval process, which will require additional paperwork.
- 10. Water Hauling-report and review
  - a. 3 deliveries in December
  - b. No applications for the driver have been submitted.
- 11. Membership Report
  - a. Swensons in Sheridan are selling their land, and have resigned as members. We now have 61 members. Dennis suggested sending them the member transfer form.
